The IQAC of Shailabala Women's Autonomous College, Cuttack has organised a one day workshop on Intellectual Property Rights on 09.02.2021 at the conference room of the college. With strict adherence to COVID-19 guidelines, around 50 participants comprising of Principal, Associate Professors, Assistant Professors, IQAC coordinator and members and students participated in this workshop. The event started with an obeisance to Shri Madhusudan Das by flower offerings by the Principal, Dr. Jaweda Hussain, Chief speaker Dr. Sushant Kumar Rout, IPR Consultant, IPFC, IED, Department of Science and Technology, Govt. Of Odisha and IQAC Coordinator, Dr. Niranjan Prasad Rath. It was followed by delivering of welcome address by Dr. Niranjan Prasad Rath, IQAC Coordinator. The inaugural speech was delivered by the Principal Dr. Jaweda Hussain. The introduction of Chief Speaker and introduction to the topic was given by Dr. Priti Pragyan Ray, Member, IQAC. Then, the technical Session was addressed by Chief Speaker, Dr. S.K Rout, IPR Consultant, Patent Information Centre, Govt. of Odisha. He explained about copyrights, patents and the importance of patents. He explained in detail that Intellectual property rights refers to the general term for the assignment of property rights through patents, copyrights and trademarks. These property rights allows the holder to exercise a monopoly on the use of the item for a specified period. He explained in detail about the four categories of intellectual property protections that included: Trade Secrets, patents, copyrights and trademarks. He informed the participants in detail about the three types of patents: utility patents, design patents, and plant patents. While the basic social objectives of intellectual property protection are as outlined above, he also emphasized that it should also be noted that the exclusive rights given are generally subject to a number of limitations and exceptions, aimed at fine-tuning the balance that has to be found between the legitimate interests of right holders and of users. He appealed the participants to form a "**Student Innovation Park**" in the college for providing the students a platform to showcase their talents.

After his enriching deliberation there was an extensive interaction session, where all the participants actively exchanged their ideas. The workshop ended with vote of thanks by Dr. S.S. Nayak, Member, IQAC. He expressed gratitude to the Principal, Dr. Jaweda Hussain, the chief Speaker, Dr. S. K.
