Applications are invited from the retired Government Servants for engagement against the following vacant non-teaching sanctioned posts initially for a period of two (02) years i.e. till completion of sixty-five years of age or till the posts are filled up by regular process, whichever is earlier. This re-engagement will be as per the terms and conditions laid down in the guidelines relating to engagement of retired Government servants issued vide G.A. Department Resolution No.23750,dated 27.08.2014 and remuneration will be paid as per Finance Department office Memorandum No.7022 dated 17.03.2018 respectively.

Eligibility

- 1. Who have retired from Government service on attaining the age of superannuation and below the age of sixty five years having good service records and are physically fit shall be eligible to be considered for re-employment.
- 2. Against whom departmental proceedings or criminal cases are contemplated / pending or who have been penalized for misconduct during the period of preceding five years will not be eligible for consideration.

Terms and Conditions

i. The re-employment shall be made initially for a period of two years subject to satisfactory performance and not beyond sixty-five years of age or till the posts are filled up by regular process whichever is earlier.

ii. Re-employed officers shall be governed by the provisions of Odisha Government Servants conduct rules, 1957 and shall be liable to be proceeded against for their misconduct, omissions and commissions as per the provisions under the Odisha Pension Rules, 1992.

The Re-employment can be terminated at any time by the under signed due to unsatisfactory performance of any of the re-employed officer by giving one month iii. notice. On the contrary if any re-employed officer desires to resign he/she shall do so by giving one month's written notice to the competent authority.

Remuneration

On engagement, the retired Government servant will avail remuneration only in consolidated manner as per prescribed remuneration structure attached to the level in the pay matrix as given in table below.
