Attainment of POs and Cos

Many of the courses have been designed to highlight the art, culture, natural resources concept that emphasizes the importance of India. In addition to this Behavioural studies, Metal health, Human rights etc have been given the importance. Post graduation and M.Phil Department have made their research area and have included Research Methodology as one of its subject. Overall the prime motive behind the design of the curriculum is to have a multi displinary approach as the case may be. Each subject's Programme outcomes (POs), Programme Specific Outcomes (PSOs) and Course outcomes(Cos)are explicitly described which has been reflected in the college website. Each course has defined a set of course outcomes and corresponding evaluation criteria. The performance of the student in each semester examination is used to compute the level of attainment of POs and PSOs. The process of course outcome assessment is based on Mid-Sem and End-Sem examinations, Seminar presentations, Projects etc. The attainment of Course Outcomes of all courses with respect to attainment levels are based on SGPAs and CGPAs which are given below:
