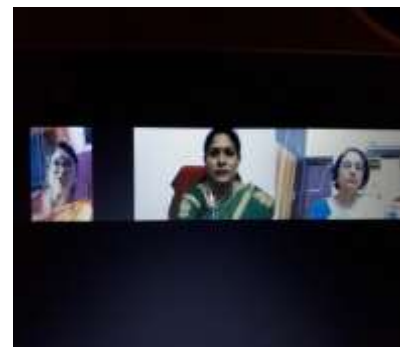
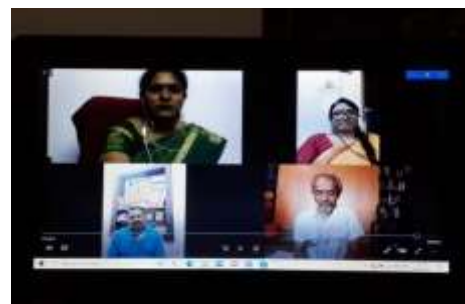

body. It can be transmitted from infected mother to the child during gestation, delivery or breast feeding. The baby can be safe from contracting the virus if mother's HIV test is done prior completion of first trimester. The HIV infected person should be treated with compassion. Sharing of towel, food, bed, swimming pool with the infected person does not spread the disease. There are various methods to control the deadly HIV to cause AIDS. Thus knowing AIDS is the first step to winning it. A number of queries were put together by the students and the resource person answered to all those aptly.
