Outcome: The program was observed with great enthusiasm and patriotic spirit. The students commemorated the sacrifice of the freedom fighters to make India free from British Raj.





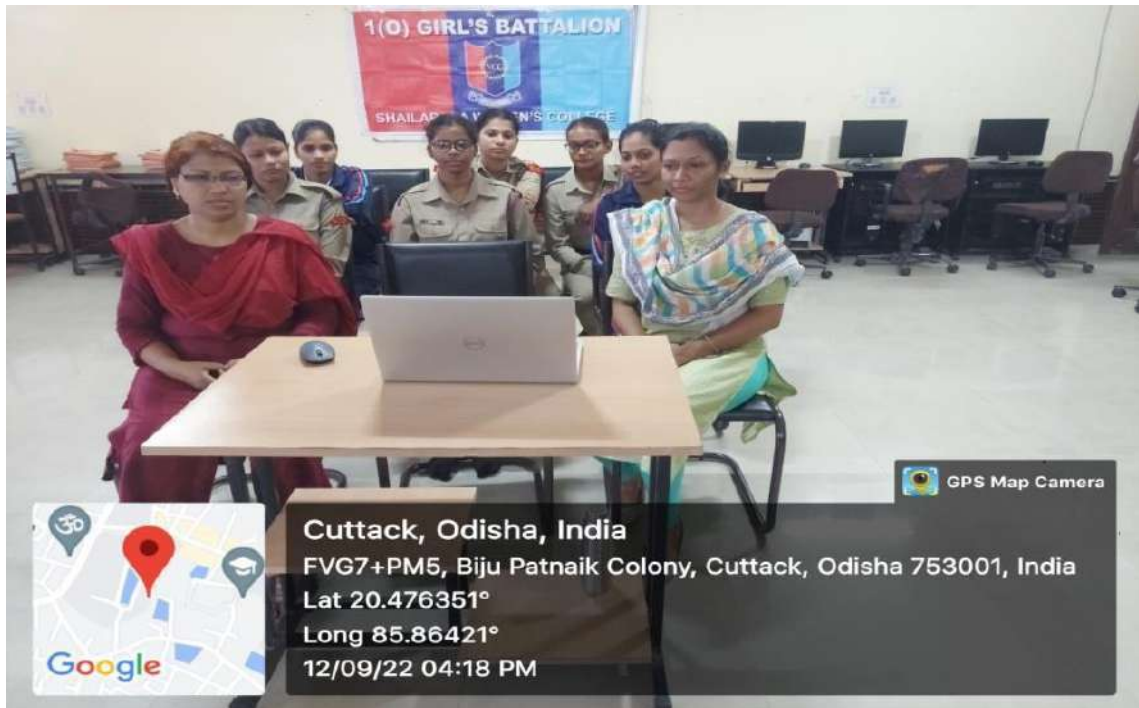


## NASHA MUKT BHARAT ABHIYAN

Breastfed children perform better on intelligence tests, are less likely to be overweight and less prone to diabetes in later life. 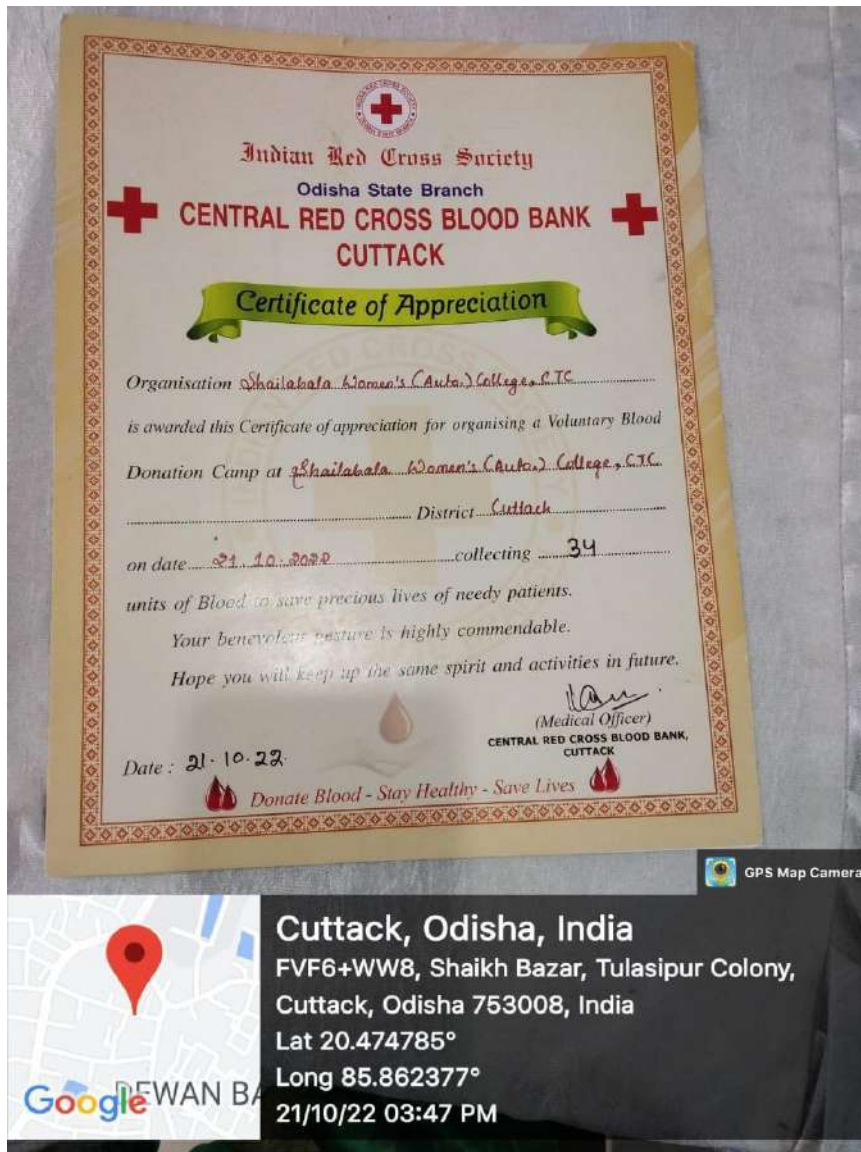

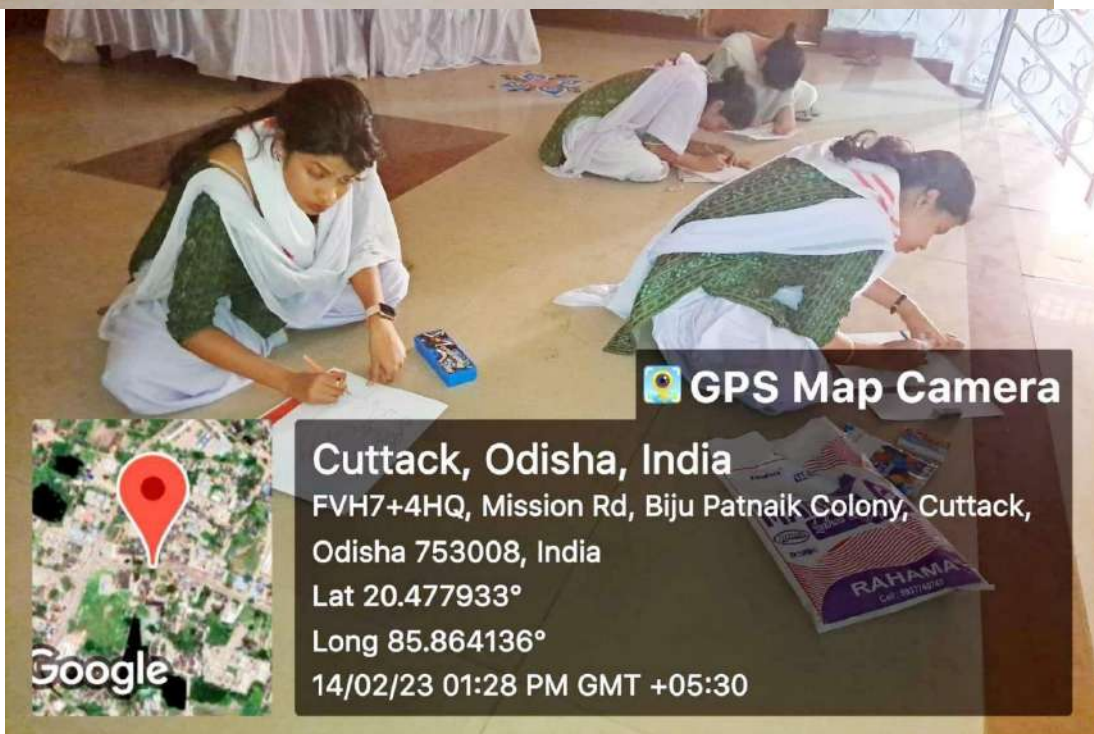

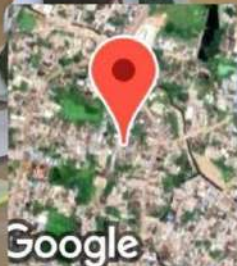
