Administrative Approval of Governor is hereby accorded for "Construction of Administrative-cum-Academic (S+8 floors) building" at Shailabala Women's (Autonomous) College, Cuttack with total estimated cost of Rs. 3521.97 lakhs (Rupees thirty five crore twenty one lakh and ninety seven thousand) only (inclusive of all taxes/ charges), subject to observance of the following conditions. The detail break up of estimates of cost is appended as Annexure- A.

- 2. The charge is debitable to "Demand No. 38-4202-Capital Outlay on Education, Sports, Arts & Culture-State Plan-State Sector-01-General Education-203-University and Higher Education-0190-Construction-37055-Construction of Govt. College Buildings" voted in Budget Estimate for the financial year 2022-23.
- 3. All the codal provisions and procedures laid down under relevant rules are to be strictly followed.
- 4. Technical Sanction (T.S.) is to be accorded by the competent technical authority before execution of work.
- 5. The R&B Division shall ensure timely completion of the work to avoid time and cost over run
- 6. Work shall be completed as per approved cost and scope of work. No escalation of cost will generally be allowed without proper justification.
- 7. Physical and financial progress report maintained by PWD shall be submitted periodically to Higher Education Department.
- 8. There should not be any change in the scope of work. Diversion of fund from one work to another will not be entertained under any circumstances.
- 9. The work may be taken up immediately observing all codal procedures.

Notification No.52279/HE dt.19th December 2022. The meeting was held under the chairmanship of Er. (Dr.) Prabhakar Swain, Chairman of the Governing Body.

Following business were transacted:-

- 1. At the outset Principal Prof. (Dr.) Gayatri Biswal welcome the chairman and all the members of Governing Body and gave the introductions of chairman and other members.
- 2. Er. (Dr.) Prabhakar Swain, Chairman of the Governing Body, expressed his gratitude to Department of Higher Education, Govt. of Odisha for giving him the responsibility to be the chairman of the Governing body of this prestigious, heritage institution. He also requested all to co-operate whole heartedly to complete his tenure to achieve the target.
- 3. Dr. Jamini Ranjan Mohanty, Administrative Bursar briefed the house regarding the history and status of NAAC Accreditation and Renewal of Autonomy of the college.
- 4. Mv Wunnam Easwar, Chartered Accountant, S/O- Late W.V.K. Rao, Flat No.-1/30, Gangotri VIP Enclave, Chandrasekharpur, Bhubaneswar-16 was nominated by the Governing Body as a member of the Finance Committee.
- 5. The minutes of last academic council meeting held on 30.09.2022 was presented by Academic Bursar and was approved by the house.
- 6. As per proposal of the Principal, the Academic Council was reconstituted. As some of the members of Academic Council have already been nominated to the Governing Body, the following members were nominated for the Academic Council which is to be reconstituted.
 - i. Academician Prof. (Dr.) Mitali Chinara, Department of Economics, Utkal University, Bhubaneswar.

ii. Commerce – Prof. Malaya Kumar Mohanty, Former Prof. G.M. College, Sambalpur.

iii. Medicine – Prof. Janmejaya Mohapatra, Gynaecologist, Acharya Harihar, PG Institute of Cancer, Cuttack.

iv. Engineer – Er. Chandeswar Behera, Retd. Chief Engineer, Cuttack.

v. Industrialist – Miss Varsha Biswal, CEO, Trupti Diary, Khurda



Further discussion was made by the Chairman with all the members of the Governing Body and invited members as well as suggestions were invited from all the members for betterment of the institution after which following resolutions were unanimously adopted.

- Keeping in view the opening of new P.G. courses, existing P.G courses and (i) enhancement of seats in UG classes, the Administrative Bursar and Academic Bursar have to prepare the required no. of posts taking into account workload of each subject. Accordingly the government may be requested to appoint permanent faculties against the vacant posts as well as to sanction new posts for smooth management of academic activities.
- (ii) The house unanimously resolved to form a committee under the chairmanship of the Governing Body Chairman Er. (Dr.) Prabhakar Swain for inviting intellectuals and leaders from Cuttack with an agenda to upgrade Shailabala Women's Autonomous College to the status of a University, which is a long pending demand of various stakeholders.
- Regarding record of the scheduled land of Science Block and Arts Block in the (iii) name of the College, Dr. Bikash Kumar Das, OIC College Development was assigned with the responsibility to consult with Sri S. K. Panda, MD, Jay Bharat, Pvt., Ltd. in order to finalise the matter with the district administration at the earliest possible.
- Govt. will be intimated for vertical expansion of the college to have more no. of (iv) galleries to accommodate the general classes.
- A committee is to be formed for the observance of college Foundation Day on (v) March 25th each year (the Birthday of Miss Shailabala Das) as mentioned in the gift deed signed on 02.02.1952.
- The 110th Foundation Day / 110th Anniversary Day of the college is to be celebrated (vi) this year inviting the Honourable Chief Minister as Chief Guest.
- A complete report on the status of the college is to be prepared keeping in view the (vii) requirement of University status, so that it can be presented to Media or Govt. officially as and when required.
