SBWAC has its distinctiveness as a century old heritage institution, being the first Women's College of Odisha. The seat of the college is the residential building of the grand old patriarch of Odisha, Utkal Gourav Madhusudan Das, the architect of modern Odisha province, an indelible episode in the history of the state. The building is no less a historical monument of the state. This building has been donated by Miss Shailabala Das, the adopted daughter of the great legendary figure Madhusudan Das towards Women's upliftment in the field of Women Education and SBWAC has been named after her. Father of the Nation Mahatma Gandhi has visited the precincts of the place. Prime Minister Nehru had also come to unveil the statue of Madhubabu. The heritage building is maintained and preserved by this HEI with the help of concerned agencies of State Government. Many prolific stalwarts visit this institution to observe the birth and death anniversaries of Madhubabu and Shailabala Das. The institution offers Post graduate degrees in 12 subjects and B.Ed degree which attracts students not only from within but also from outside the state. This HEI is committed to its social commitment of serving the tribal and physically challenged students for long.
