RATIONALE OF THE SURVEY:

The students are an integral part of the college. In order to capture the teaching-learning and evaluation experiences of students for the academic session 2022-2023, a questionnaire of 21 parameters has been framed as per NAAC format and forwarded online. The questionnaire of the survey included 20 close-ended questions and 1 open ended question to which responses are given anonymously by the students of the institution with the help of Google Forms. The survey components included college level feedback on teaching-learning and evaluation. Only the pre-final year students i.e UG 5th Semester and PG 3rd semester students were allowed to participate in the survey.

SURVEY QUESTIONS:

The survey questions included the parameter like how much of the syllabus was covered in the class, how well did the teachers prepare for the classes, how well were the teachers able to communicate, the teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as, fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers, was your performance in assignments discussed with you, the institute takes active interest in promoting internship, studentexchange, field visit opportunities for students, The teaching and mentoring process in your institution facilitates you in cognitive, social and emotional growth, the institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow, teachers inform you about your expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes, your mentor does a necessary follow-up with an assigned task to you, the teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications, the teachers identify your strengths and encourage you with providing right level of challenges, teachers are able to identify your weaknesses and help you to overcome them, The

institution makes effort to engage students in the monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process, The institute/ teachers use student centric participative learning, such experiential methods, as learning and problem solving methodologies for enhancing learning experiences, teachers encourage you to participate in extracurricular activities, efforts are made by the institute/ employability skills and inculcate life soft skills. teachers to skills to make you ready for the world of work, what percentage of teachers use ICT tools such while LCD projector, Multimedia, etc. as teaching and the overall quality of teaching-learning process in your institute is very good. The open ended question was to suggest three observation / suggestions to improve the overall teaching -learning experience of the college.

OUTCOME OF THE SURVEY:

Total 466 students responded to Student Satisfaction Survey. Results demonstrated student satisfaction in almost all the questions relating to the quality of teaching learning and evaluation procedure employed at the college. However, many students expressed their need for having more of smart classrooms and better laboratory facilities. The survey would definitely help to initiate remedial action to improve the facilities whenever and wherever it is required. The result of the survey has provided a base to plan for betterment of the students in the near future. The analysis of the survey conducted showed that majority of the students were satisfied on the teaching -learning and evaluation process of the college.


ACTION TAKEN:






























What percentage of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, Multimedia, etc. while teaching?
