- (a) The minutes of the last meeting were confirmed.
- (b) The P.G Syllabus was approved.
- (c) The detailed list of question setters and examiners (both internal and external), members of the Moderation board and Board of Conducting Examiners were recommended in the prescribed format.
- (d) The marking pattern of each paper was fixed at 70 marks ^{in end sem and 30 marks in mid sem} for each 05 units. The paper carrying 50 marks would comprise 04 units.
- (e) Non-credit skill based Certificate Course i.e "Human Rights" was approved. The marking pattern recommended was full Marks=50, Total number of Units=03, each carrying 12 marks and a project containing 14 marks. The total teaching hours for this course would be 35 hours and the examination would be conducted by the Department.
